Work-Scholarship Program

2020-2021

The work-scholarships are awarded to students with critical financial needs who maintain a minimum of 2.5 grade point average. The scholarship pays for one-half of the yearly tuition. In cases of extreme financial need such as students with single parents or no parents, very large families, or extreme poverty, full scholarships may be awarded. The students on a half scholarship work one hour every day during the school year. Those on full scholarships work the equivalent of two hours for every school day.
